

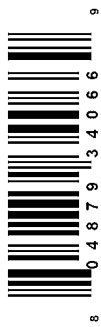

Nina Yardley

In sadness, we share the news that Pastor Nina Yardley, a retired local pastor in the Desert Southwest Conference, died on Friday, Sept. 20, 2024.

Nina is survived by her loving spouse Greg, their children and a multitude of lives she touched throughout her remarkable journey. She is remembered for her resilience and the capacity to love deeply.

Pastor Nina was a devoted wife, mother and servant of her community. She is remembered for her unwavering faith, commitment to helping others and her boundless love for her family.

Nina's professional journey began in August of 1969 when she joined the Armed Forces Cooperative Insurance Association in Fort Leavenworth, Kansas, where she excelled at accounting and bookkeeping. In October of 1970, she married Greg Yardley and relocated to Topeka. She continued her career at Volume Shoe Corporation, transitioning to a role as Teacher's Aide after considering completing her university studies in education.

In August of 1972, Nina moved with her family to Overland Park, while Greg pursued graduate studies in special education. As life unfolded, she took on various positions, including a full-charge bookkeeper for SOME industries in Mission and an outpatient billing clerk at Stormont-Vail Hospital, showcasing her adaptable skills. Nina's signature tenure began in November of 1974, with the Social Security Administration in Topeka, where she became a data review technician and a service representative. Seeking greater responsibility and opportunities in accounting, she continued to build her expertise. By May 1985, Nina had embraced a managerial

role at Sheltered Living Inc. in Topeka, where she thrived, despite the demanding hours.

In 1991, a new chapter began when Greg accepted a position in Yuma, prompting Nina to follow him. There, she quickly resumed her bookkeeping and accounting work at a community non-profit social services agency. Their journey

eventually led them to Phoenix, where Nina seized the opportunity to further her education and earned a B.S. degree in Computer Science. She went on to work at Southwest Behavioral Services, where she was promoted to Vice President of Computer Services, reflecting her hard work and dedication.

In 1996, following Greg's retirement, Nina discovered her calling to the ministry. After attending Course of Study school in Claremont, California, she became a licensed local pastor in 2011. She served at the United Methodist Church of the Good Shepherd in Kearny. This period filled Nina with joy as she connected deeply with her congregation, bringing her faith to life in meaningful ways. However, as her health began to decline, she made the difficult decision to retire from the ministry. She retired in 2017 and returned to Gilbert, where she lived until Alzheimer's disease took hold, yet she remained surrounded by the love of her husband, family and friends.

Pastor Nina will forever hold a special place in the hearts of all who knew her. God bless her and her memory.

Lucia also found time to run the Lifeline Medical Supply office, and having her friends to visit. In 1997 when Guillermo retired, they moved to their final home in Tucson.

Pinal County Health Department in Oracle reopens with more services

The newly remodeled Pinal County Health Department has reopened and now offers additional services and access to important county programs not previously available in the Tri-Community region.

Prior to the remodeling, residents of the area had access to WIC services, and basic public health services such as immunizations. The new clinic now has an office that will allow residents to purchase copies of birth and death

certificates and also holds a space for a Family Advocacy Center. The clinic is equipped with new state of the art equipment and has a much more modern design.

The Family Advocacy Center is only open in conjunction with local law enforcement and is accessed during sensitive cases involving child abuse and sexual assault of minors. The center is designed with the needs of the child in mind to provide a safe place for victims and their families

for examinations and forensic interviews that may be needed in sensitive cases. Previously, victims would need to travel to San Tan Valley to access these services and forensic interviews.

The clinic building improves access to services and helps local residents to avoid lengthy commutes to access these important community services.

The WIC Clinic and immunization clinic reopened Oct. 1, 2024 and will be open on Tuesdays and Fridays from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.. Vital Records offices will be available on Tuesdays from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Immunizations available include Tetanus, MMR, Flu and Covid. They can also administer tuberculosis skin tests on site.

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SHIP is a national program of the Administration for Community Living, an operating division of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services.

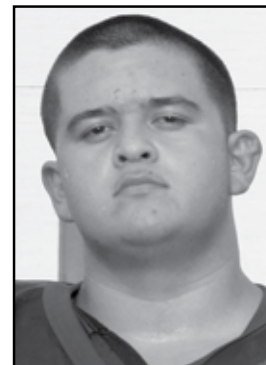

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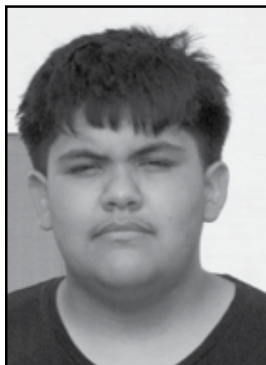

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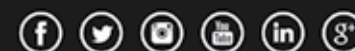

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SUPERIOR, PINAL COUNTY, ARIZONA, AMENDING ORDINANCE 17-140 (ZONING ORDINANCE) BY ADOPTING AMENDMENTS TO ARTICLE V (SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL ZONE DISTRICTS), SECTION 5.1, PERMITTED USES: AND RECOMMENDING AMENDMENTS TO ADOPTED TOWN CODE, CHAPTER 7, SECTION 7-1-13, AREAS ZONED FOR LIVESTOCK-CONDITIONS.

WHEREAS, the Town Council has, at its regularly scheduled meeting held on February 1, 2024 studied and considered Ordinance 2024-185, an Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 174-140 (Town's Zoning Ordinance) by adopting amendments to Article V, Single Family Residential Zone Districts; and amendments to Town Code, Chapter 7, Section 7-1-13, Areas Zoned for Livestock-Conditions; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the Town to enact this amendment to the Town's Zoning Ordinance in order to enhance the quality of life and to protect the health, safety and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission of the Town of Superior, in a regular session assembled on the 1st day of February, 2024, heard proposed; and in a regular session assembled on the 4th date of April 2024, approved Resolution No. 2024-02, a Resolution recommending that the Town Council amend Ordinance 17-140 by adopting the proposed amendments to Article V (Single Family Residential Zone Districts), Section 5.1 Permitted Uses as well as adopting amendments to Chapter 7, Section 7-1-13 of Superior Town Code, Areas Zoned for Live-Stock Conditions as set forth in Section I and Section II, respectively, below Ordinance No. 2024-185

NOW, THEREFORE, THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SUPERIOR, PINAL COUNTY, ARIZONA, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: ZONING CODE

ARTICLE V, SECTION 5.1, PERMITTED USES

Section 5.1 PERMITTED USES

A. Permitted uses in the AR, RR, ER, SR, R1-8 and R1-5 Single Family Residential Zone Districts shall be only those uses listed as permitted by-right within the respective zone district. Permitted uses are subject to all other applicable standards of this Ordinance.

1. Non-commercial keeping of fowl subject to the following criteria and restrictions;

a. Number of chickens limited to not more than six (6) per lot.

b. Location of containment areas must be within the rear or side yard of the lot.

c. Roosters shall be prohibited.

d. The enclosure for fowl must be at least fifteen feet from a neighboring property and the size of such enclosure shall not exceed two hundred (200) square feet. The height of the enclosure shall not exceed eight (8) feet, or the height of the fence line (whichever is shorter).

e. The enclosure for fowl shall be maintained and manure picked up and disposed of or composted at least twice weekly. If manure is to be composted, the compost shall be maintained in such a manner that prevents the migration of insects.

f. Water sources for fowl shall be provided with adequate overflow drainage.

g. Feed shall be stored in insect-proof and rodent-proof containers.

h. Fowl shall not run at-large, outside of the confines of the property.

B. Additional use in the AR, RR and ER Zone Districts.

4. Keeping of fowl subject to the following criteria and restrictions:

a. Number of chickens limited to not more than six (6) per 1/2 acre.

SECTION II: TOWN CODE

7-1-13 AREAS ZONED FOR LIVESTOCK-CONDITIONS

Section 7-1-13 Areas Zoned for Livestock-Conditions

A. Where otherwise lawful within certain zoning districts as provided in this Code to keep livestock, fowl; or rodents, the land on which said animals are kept or maintained shall not be less than one (1) acre and the authorization

2. No fowl; rodents, or livestock shall be cooped, stabled or confined in any building within one hundred (100) feet from any residence, dining, or sleeping quarters which may be situated on adjacent land and all such animals shall be kept in suitable enclosures and shall not be permitted to run at large. All such enclosures shall be maintained at all times in a clean and sanitary condition.

SECTION III: The Zoning Administrator of the Town of Superior, AZ is hereby given the authority to make any non-substantive changes to Ordinance No. 2024-185 These non-substantive changes include such things as grammatical errors, or erroneous references in the Ordinance or any other such non-substantive changes provided a report is given to the Planning and Zoning Commission indicating which changes are to be made.

SECTION IV: Severability. If any section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, phrase, or portion of this Resolution, or the application to any person or place is held to be unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance The Planning and Zoning Commission declares that it would have adopted this Ordinance and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Resolution in spite of the fact that one or more of the same be declared unconstitutional or invalid.
