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

ASARCO announces use of autonomous vehicles

Mining technology continues to evolve throughout the industry. With the ongoing advancement of the technology that powers autonomous vehicles and robotic operations, every industry is on the cusp of transformation to implement these new technologies. ASARCO-Grupo Mexico announced to the community that it has officially informed the United Steelworkers Union that ASARCO will be implementing the use of Autonomous Haulage System at the Ray Mine. These notifications are required based on current labor contracts with the unions. The company announced that zero jobs will be lost due to the change of equipment. ASARCO and Union officials were scheduled to meet on Oct. 17 according to the public flyer. At press time the outcome of the meeting was not available. In the announcement, ASARCO reported that the implementation of the new AHS system will be complete by October 2025. The implementation plan calls for current employees to to be trained to advance into other positions at ASARCO as part of the arrival of the AHS at the Ray Mine.

The AHS system is expected to improve the safety of employees, equipment and production as well as improve efficiencies at the Ray Mine.



BLM releases draft environmental assessment for Redhawk Copper

The Bureau of Land Management, Safford Field Office, will release a draft environmental assessment for the proposed Copper Creek Exploration Project and the associated Mining Plan of Operations on Nov. 7. The proposed project is located on BLM-managed public lands, approximately nine miles east of the Town of Mammoth in unincorporated Pinal County, Arizona. the 45-day comment that ends Dec. 22.

The applicant, Redhawk Copper, Inc. (Redhawk), submitted an application for a Mining Plan of Operations to the BLM SFO. If approved, Redhawk would be authorized to disturb up to 18 acres of BLM-managed public lands, which includes six acres for 67 drill pad sites and 12 acres for associated access roads. Before the Project is complete, Redhawk would reclaim 14 acres of the surface disturbance. The remaining 4 acres would be widening of roads that are currently used for recreation and other activities and would remain open for use at project completion. Interested parties may review the draft environmental assessment and the Mining Plan of Operations then may submit comments online via the BLM National NEPA Register or by email to <u>BLM_AZ_SFO_CopperCreek@blm.gov</u>. 
The Lady 'Cats closed out their season with a record of 7-22. They were ranked #6 in the 1A East region, with a #29 ranking for all of 1A.

Court volunteer program seeking additional volunteers

In 1977, a juvenile court judge concerned about making drastic decisions with insufficient information conceived the idea of citizen volunteers speaking up for the best interests of abused and neglected children in the courtroom. This created the Court Appointed Special Advocate Program.



The Story of Truck Truck

My eldest son David was in kindergarten and we lived just east of Mesa, outside the city limits in 1975. The elementary school had just notified my wife Kathi and me that David probably had learning disabilities and we agreed to their placing him in special education during his elementary school years, starting with first grade. Knowing that the process would be difficult for him, I decided that I should do something special for him.

David was always delighted when the UPS truck arrived at our home with parcels, sometimes with gifts from his grandparents. He called the UPS delivery truck "Box Truck". So, I decided to build him a sidewalk push truck.

Our home was on a dirt street intersection with a tall saguaro cactus in the middle of one. With no hard surfaces available for him and two brothers to use, I selected large children's tricycle front wheels. For several months, I walked the dirt alleyways of our neighborhood before trash day and found large 16" front tricycle wheels.

I removed the pedal cranks and welded in steel tubing. Later on, when we had more financial resources, I purchased new 16" garden cart wheels with semi-pneumatic tires equipped with ball bearing hubs. I also carted home various discarded washing machines and dryers whose cabinets became material for seat, fenders, cab, roof and hood. I based the design on old truck story pictures that my mother had read to me when I was a young child. I scrounged steel channel for a frame

from my across the street neighbor who collected such stuff. I welded up the frame with an arc welder that I purchased from Sears in 1962 for \$88 with my first job paycheck. Since I was, then, working as a certified aircraft mechanic, I had access to used threaded rod-end bearings that had failed inspection, which became steering linkage. Square tubing became the primary front axle structure which pivoted in the middle.

I fabricated front wheel spindles from 1/2" round rod stock. Then incorporated all of the steering angles similar to our very aging 1948 Chevy carryall station wagon, including tow out on turns.

I had access to sheet metal brake where I worked at Falcon Field airport to bend up the body parts. I designed the bed to hinge so it would function as a dump truck, too. I was unable to come up with a suitable steering wheel, so I fabricated it from steel tubing.

My sons David, Mark and Tim were all involved with the project. They were all delighted with the results. We have taken the truck truck to picnics, church socials and camp meetings, where it always becomes the children's favorite activity.

My son Davis is now 54 and nearing retirement as senior accountant with UPS in Dallas. That makes the truck truck (the name David gave it) nearly 50 years old and it has survived a lot of children and the test of time.
