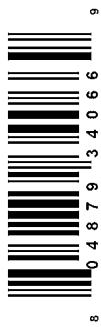

Mila Besich renamed to EPA's Small Communities subcommittee

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) announced last week the appointment of 16 new members to the Local Government Advisory Committee (LGAC), as well as the reappointments of 13 existing members. For the first time in the committee's history, membership will be majority female, including all members of the committee's leadership.

"The Biden-Harris Administration has made a commitment to advancing diversity, equity, inclusion, and accessibility across the federal government," said EPA Administrator Michael S. Regan. "Today's announcement is the latest example of this commitment in action. In addition to a majority of female members, this important committee is comprised of individuals from across the country, representing the diversity of America, so we can reflect a range of input as we craft regulations impacting their communities."

The 37-member LGAC will have 24 females and 13 males, including 13 people of color, and representation from 27 different states. The Administrator also appointed 5 new and 15 returning members to the LGAC's Small Communities Advisory Subcommittee (SCAS). Superior Mayor Mila Besich has been renamed to this subcommittee.

Mayor Leirion Gaylor Baird of Lincoln, Nebraska will continue as the LGAC's chair, with Mayor Lucy Vinis of Eugene, Oregon as vice chair. Administrator Regan also appointed Mayor Katie Rosenberg of Wausau, Wisconsin to join Ann Mallek, Supervisor of Albemarle County, Virginia, as co-chairs of the SCAS.

"I am grateful to Administrator Regan for reappointment as Chair of the Local Government Advisory Committee," said Mayor Gaylor Baird of Lincoln, Nebraska. "Members of LGAC have an historic opportunity to shape the implementation of EPA policies so that they best serve the diverse interests and concerns of the residents we represent."

"EPA's LGAC is an amazing opportunity for local officials to amplify their voices and be directly engaged in the policy development process at the federal level," said Clarence Anthony, CEO and Executive Director of National League of Cities (NLC). "At NLC, we are thrilled that these remarkable new appointees will be able to provide critical insights and recommendations to help ensure that federal policies, rules, and regulations are effective and practical for communities of all sizes. The LGAC offers local leaders a necessary seat at the table that will help deliver better outcomes for all of the residents in America's communities."

In 2024, the Committee will provide input on the proposed Lead and Copper Rule Improvements, the draft Strategy for Reducing Plastic Pollution, EPA's efforts to develop a cumulative impact framework, and to improve community-level communication and engagement on climate change issues.

Members were chosen from a pool of more than 60 highly qualified candidates. Selections for the one- and two-year terms were made based on the applicant pool and in accordance with the LGAC charter to achieve balance and diversity in terms of geographic location, gender, ethnicity, and stakeholder perspective.

Background

Chartered in 1993 under the Federal Advisory Committee Act, the Local Government Advisory Committee is comprised of elected and appointed officials at local, state, tribal and territorial governments within the U.S., who provide independent policy advice to the EPA Administrator on a broad range of issues affecting local governments. The Small Community Advisory Subcommittee was established by EPA in 1996 to advise the Administrator on environmental issues of concern to the residents of smaller communities. New members are recruited every fall.

The Superior Enterprise Center in conjunction with Central Arizona College and the Town of Superior hosted the official registrations for the first welding courses at the Superior Enterprise Center. At least two dozen residents from Superior and the surrounding Copper Corridor signed up for the course. At this time the class can host 10 students and the others who attended the registration day will be placed on a waiting classes should spaces open up.

The Superior Enterprise Center is housed at the Superior Multi-Gen Center, which is the former home of the original Superior High School. Rebuild Superior Chairman Manny Guzman explained that there have not been college credit skilled job training programs for Superior residents or students in Superior since at least 1999 when the original high school closed. Students today can partake in the Cobre Valley Institute of Technology (CVIT) programs, but they have to travel to Globe to partake in the welding programs. The long term plan for the center is to offer programs through CVIT as well for high school

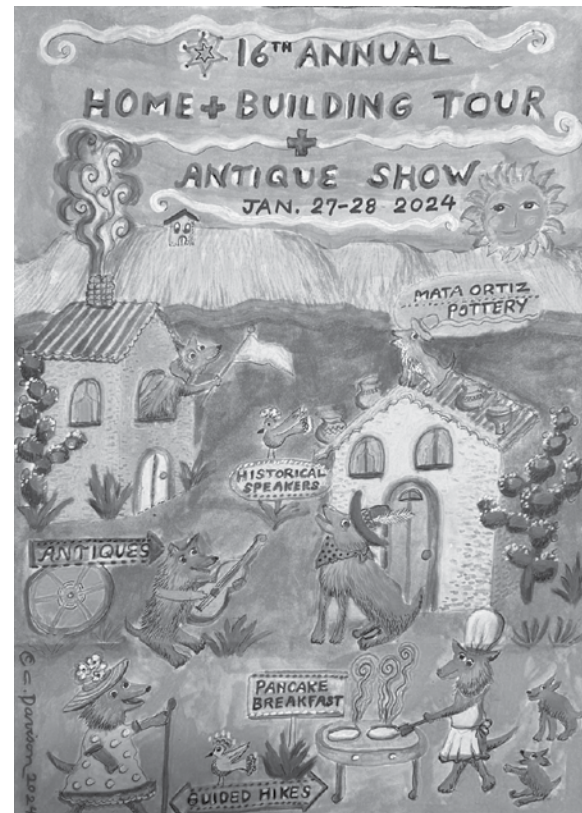

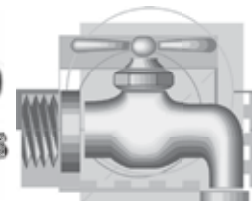

students throughout the CVIT district.

When the Town of Superior first began the planning and development of a multi-gen center in 2016, there was always intention to have more skilled job training programs offered in the community not only for high school aged students, but also for life-long adult learners. The Superior Enterprise Center also provides entrepreneur support and training for small businesses and non-profits.

The welding curriculum is accredited through Central Arizona College which allows the students to earn a certificate for the program once the credits are completed. The students will begin their courses at the Superior Enterprise Center on Jan. 16, 2024.

Resolution Copper has been a strong supporter of the program and development of the multi-gen center. Through their support, the courses offered at the Superior Enterprise Center are free for residents of the Copper Corridor. Their support and funding have helped to complete the required electrical upgrades to the center.

Resolution Copper has provided funding to the Town through a 2019 agreement to fund the development and purchase of the Multi-Gen center. Their funding assisted the town with acquiring the campus in 2021. The Superior Town Council allocated funds from their American Rescue Plan Act funding to purchase the welding equipment and other building upgrades.

A ribbon cutting and open house is being planned for the welding program on Jan. 23.
