additional volunteers.

Calling all quilters: Copper Thimbles seeks new members

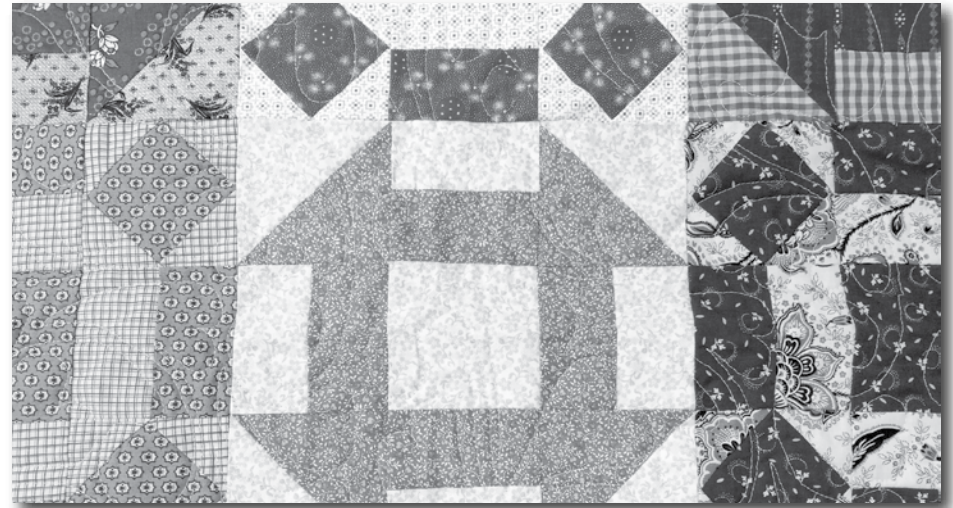

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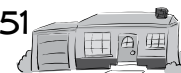

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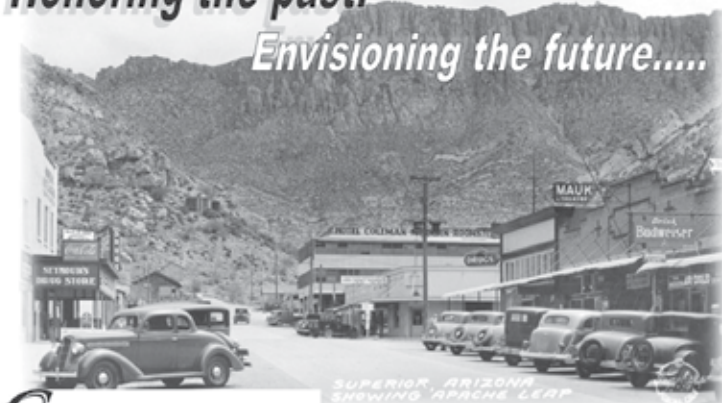

Conference Championships. Competing in the tournament were San Manuel, Mt. Vista, Hayden, Globe, Eloy, Miami and Dishchii'bihoh. With two mats on the gym floor, and constant matches, it was a long afternoon of wrestling, and many of the wrestlers left it all on the mat.

The Mt. Vista wrestlers from Oracle had 7 wrestlers leave with hardware. McDermott took fourth and Robles took first place at

73 lbs. Kelso took third place at 142 lbs. For the girls division, Whitaker took third place at 100ish. Chavez took second at 130ish. Another Chavez took second place and Siegfried took third place at 160ish.
