Lisa Migliore was surprised when she got a voicemail from a phone number she didn't recognize.

"Hi Lisa. I'm Andrea Perez with the Phoenix Suns." Gila Rose Dance Studio was invited to perform for a Prime Time or Halftime performance on Thursday, Dec. 19, 2024. Lisa was faced with a decision. Try to pull everything together and have a contract signed and ready in eight days or be waitlisted for a possible performance next season. Gila Rose just opened in August 2024 and their studio is very new. Even veteran teams would be hesitant to make such a commitment in that short time frame.

Most teams have a year to prepare a performance. They are usually allotted 45 days to make all the important decisions: costumes, music, choreography, etc. and get it sent in and approved by the Suns Entertainment Group. Lisa and Dallas Pace, both instructors with Gila Rose, had no doubt in their team and community and used their personal money for their down payments and locked in their time slot.

They faced a few challenges, such as putting together a routine with choreography that would suit each of the girls' ages and skill levels and raising the funds required by the Suns organization so close to the Holidays. Not to mention that this is the peak time for illness, and a number of the little dancers, their families, and their coaches all fought off such illnesses and did their best to



He attended Northern Arizona University (Arizona State College) for one year, but then returned to Superior and worked in the mines for about seven years. A serious mining accident then sent him in the direction of his career in education.

After obtaining his bachelor's degree in Elementary Education, Camerino started in 1973 as a classroom teacher in Guadalupe, Arizona, but he then moved into administrative roles, and gained his master's in counseling. In education Camerino's greatest achievements have been both at the local and the national levels. He was proud of his influential years, 1982-1992 and 1993-94, as the Principal at Garfield School, an inner-city school in Phoenix, where student achievement was boosted by parent involvement, keeping the gangs out of the schools, and a bilingual program that eventually became nationally famous. Camerino's bilingual program at Garfield came to the notice of then-U.S. Secretary of Education under President Ronald Reagan, William Bennett, who personally visited the program at Garfield and then changed his mind about the value of bilingual programs, after seeing that the one at Garfield really worked. Bennett's change of mind allowed federal bilingual programs to remain funded under President Reagan. As a result of Camerino's contact with William Bennett, Nancy Reagan invited Camerino to the White House for the inauguration of her campaign against drugs in schools and then Camerino was invited to serve, and did serve under two successive presidents, Reagan and George H. W. Bush, on the President's National Commission for Drug Free Schools.

Camerino will be greatly missed by friends and family. He and his wife, Judith, together have six children (Debbi, Danielle (Phillip), Camerino III (Rene), Isabel (Barry), Laura (Chris) and Emily), 13 grandchildren (Zain, S.J., Daniela (Maria), Gabriela, Azalea, Camryn (Alex), Camerino IV, Amanda (Evan), Gwynneth, Aiden (Jade), Liberty, Ellen and Jack) and one great-grandchild (Quinn). Camerino's older brother Hector, and older sister, Geri, will also miss him, as will numerous cousins, nephews and nieces. Camerino is preceded in death by his younger brother, Steve, his younger sister, Punkin, and his parents.




Derek Anaya took fifth place at 157 lbs.; Jose Torres took fourth at 106 lbs.; and Sean McDermott took third place at 177 lbs.

During the first day of wrestling, Hayden wrestled through some tough team duals. Concluding their team duals on the second day, the Lobos took on Casa Grande and Florence.


Only one Lobo made it into the individual section of the tournament, heavyweight Ben Quesada. Suffering a 4-10 loss against Valley Christian, then


Hayden's Julius Pinkard wrestles his Florence opponent. Nathaniel Lopez | CANP
