Joe was proud of his faith and was a proud member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. He loved

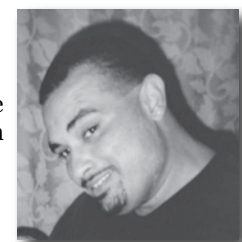
being involved in the church activities alongside his son, Anthony.

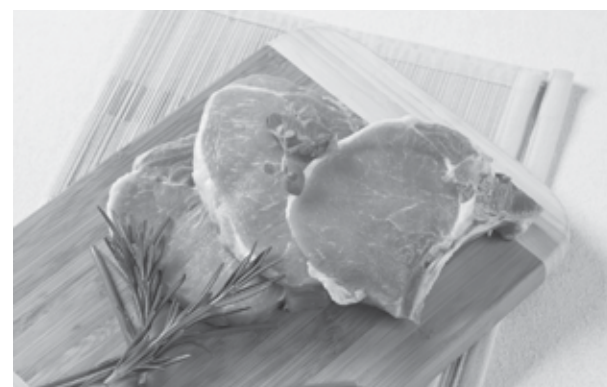

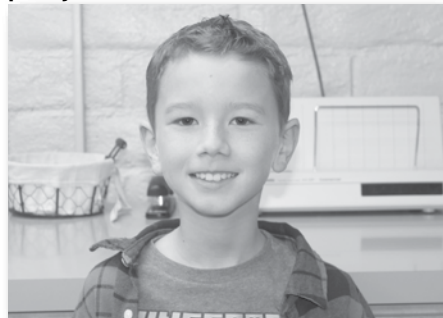

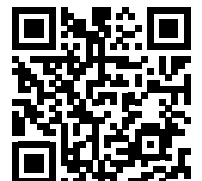
