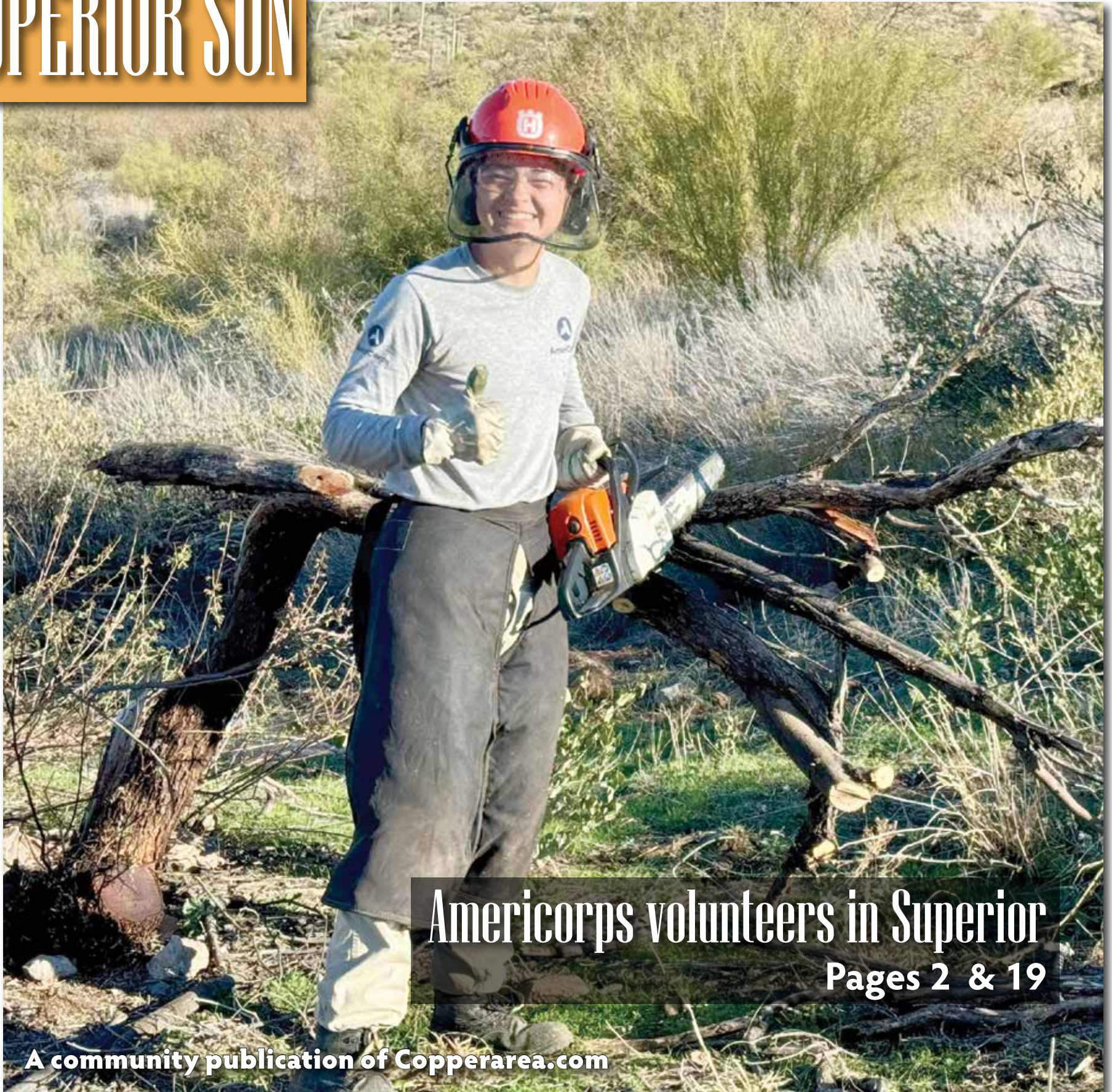
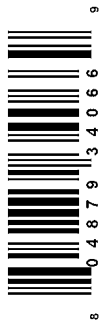

Americorps NCCC serve Superior

The Town of Superior has welcomed its fourth Americorps NCCC team to work on projects in Superior. The nine team members and their team leader Lauryn arrived in early January and have been steadily working on fire break maintenance and improvements on current fire breaks. Their work on the fire breaks was completed early and they quickly went to work giving the exterior of the food bank a new coat of paint.

During the month of February, their focus has been working with the Legends of Superior Trails Inc. helping to maintain the LOST trails. The focus for the trails have been on the Panther to Pinal segment of the LOST Trail. As the trails become more well used, they often need some work on the alignment and also tending to the brush in the area.

The Earth Team 6 will finish their work at the Boyce Thompson Arboretum where they will assist in a variety of projects at the Arboretum. Each of the three entities provided funding or in-kind support to ensure the team had proper direction and instruction. Extreme Property Solutions was contracted to be the teams project manager for the work on the fire breaks and LOST Trails.

Many of the local non-profits and residents in Superior have

hosted the Americorps team for meals and have generously provided snacks for the team. Each team member receives a small stipend each month for their food and personal needs but that does not go very far. The Town of Superior is responsible for providing a safe place for the team to reside during their stay in Superior. This year, the Americorps team has resided in the Superior Multi-Gen Center (Original Superior High School).

“The hospitality that we as a community have provided to our Americorps teams over the years has earned us an award from Americorps,” explained Mayor Mila Besich. “Our Superior spirit of welcoming others into our community and supporting youth, really shines when we host these teams.”

After completing their service contract with Americorps NCCC, the students then receive educational scholarships or reductions in student loan balances. The program provides these young Americans an opportunity to serve other communities, learn additional skills and prepare for future career and educational opportunities.

James Schenck, a local resident and intern for the Town of Superior, provides direct support to the team throughout their

Pinal County courting voters for approval of road tax renewal

On Feb. 22, Pinal County staff, including Tara Harman, senior transportation planner, and District 4 Supervisor Jeff McClure, hosted an open house at the San Manuel Community Center. The meeting was to discuss and bring awareness to the Preserving Our Future effort.

Originally passed in 1986, and renewed in 2005, Pinal County's Half-Cent Road Fund is local funding

used to preserve and build roads through the county. The Half-Cent Road Fund is the only funding for the Transportation Improvement and Maintenance Program, which develops five-year transportation plans, and reviews citizen submitted roadway improvement recommendations. The fund is currently set to expire in 2026, so Pinal County is bringing attention to the fate the county and its roads could face if the funding expires.

Tara Harman also informed those in attendance that if they have a suggested road that needs work, they can

submit a Transportation Project Request. Those requests must be for county-maintained roads only and can be submitted at <https://www.pinal.gov/848/Project-Request-Form>.
