

Fatal accident closes highway near Oracle

A fatal collision Monday, March 11, had SR 77 closed between Biosphere Road and Oro Ford in Oracle for nearly eight hours while officials investigated the cause and the area cleaned.

According to Arizona Department of Public Safety Public Information Officer Bart Graves, at approximately 11:08 a.m. on Monday, March 11, a three-vehicle collision involving two commercial vehicles and a passenger vehicle occurred at milepost 98 near Oracle.

Graves said a commercial vehicle traveling northbound crossed the centerline and sideswiped a second

commercial vehicle traveling southbound. The driver of the truck overcorrected to the left after the initial impact and again crossed the centerline at a sharp angle impacting a passenger vehicle.

The driver of the passenger vehicle was deceased on scene. The driver was later identified as Jillilyn Marin, 19, of Globe.

Following the collision, the semi rolled over and caught fire.

“A trooper managed to remove the driver of the semi before his vehicle caught fire. He was taken to a Tucson hospital,” Graves said.

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


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OBITUARIES

Job Summary:

Performs a variety of tasks in the operation and maintenance of a wastewater treatment plant including maintenance of equipment, quality control/testing and day-to-day activities on an assigned shift. This position typically holds or is working towards an intermediate level wastewater treatment certification.

Essential Functions:

- Operates treatment facilities to control flow and processing of water/wastewater, sludge, and effluent
- Diagnoses operating problems and performs necessary corrective action during work shift
- Monitors gauges, meters, and control panels
- Observes variations in operating conditions and interprets meter and gauge readings and test results to determine process adjustment requirements
- Operates valves and gates either manually or by remote control
- Starts and stops pump, engines, and generators to control and adjust flow and treatment processes
- Maintains shift log and records meter and gauge readings
- Collects samples and performs routine laboratory tests and analyses
- Performs routine maintenance functions and custodial duties
- Makes operating decisions in absence of supervisory personnel
- Understands and carries out oral and written directions
- Establishes and maintains cooperative relationships with those contacted during the course of work
- Performs other duties as required.



Job Summary:

Under general supervision, assists in the planning, coordination and supervision of a wide variety of indoor or outdoor recreation activities, for all ages, sponsored by the Town of Superior. This is a contract funded position and is only guaranteed for three years or until funding expires.

Essential Functions:

- Determines community needs and desires
- Develops/promotes community interest in recreational programs/activities
- Coordinates recreational programs and activities with other public and private agencies
- Interacts with public and private agencies and individuals to solicit funds for program activities
- Conducts classes, workshops, meetings, clubs and special events; coordinates recreational programs with service agencies within the community
- Coordinates special event applications, working with applicants to prepare plans, verifying compliance with application requirements, organizing meetings with the event committee and
- Prepares reports and maintains records
- Orders supplies and equipment and maintains accurate records of orders, expenditures and receipts
- Inspects recreational areas on a daily basis to ensure compliance with sanitary regulations
- Selects volunteers and assigns, schedules and coordinates their activities
- May staff and maintain a concession stand at a recreational facility or sporting event
- May collect money and prepare/maintain cash receipts records
- Be available for special events on evenings and weekends
- Flexible schedule to maintain a 40-hour work week.

Requirements:

Must have knowledge of recreational, cultural and social needs of the community; recreation program and activity planning techniques; and purchasing and supervisory principles and practices. Must be skilled in making recreation program decisions; analyzing, interpreting and reporting research findings; selecting and developing recreational activities suitable for individual and group interest; and establishing and maintaining effective relationships with the public and members of Town staff.

Physical Requirements and Work Environment:

There is a need to stand, stoop, walk, lift light to moderate objects (up to 50 pounds) and perform other similar actions during the course of the work day. The Town of Superior promotes a drug/alcohol free work environment through the use of mandatory pre-employment drug testing.
