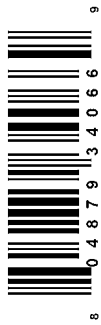

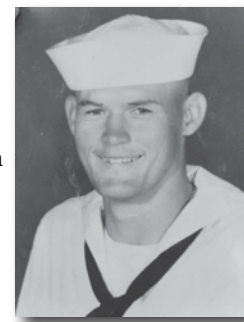

CAC Aravaipa Campus provides tour of revamped welding area

Andrew Clegg, Executive Director Career and Workforce Training for Central Arizona College (CAC), offered a tour of the Welding Class area on May 1, 2024. Copper Corridor High School staff were invited to attend this informational tour. Educators from Hayden and San Manuel High Schools were in attendance to learn more about the welding program to be offered at CAC.

The welding area has recently been upgraded by course students after CAC was approached by the Asarco mine seeking training for high school students in the area. Classes for high school students in the Copper Corridor are planned to begin this upcoming fall semester. It is hoped that this opportunity will expand to the others in the community in the near future.

Clegg indicated that the welding courses would be available to a limited number of high school students at no cost. CAC will offer courses in Structural Welding Technology, leading to AAS & Certificates

in cooperation with Cobre Valley Institute of Technology (CVIT). Clegg stated, "Ray and Hayden students will be able to enroll through Aja with CVIT. San Manuel can reach out to Maria for assistance in signing up" (Maria Munoz, AVC/STC Director – Student Services, email address is Maria.Munoz@centralaz.edu). San Manuel students can also obtain additional information from the high school Welding instructor Joann McCrea.

A total of 16 students would attend classes Monday through Thursday. The first courses scheduled will be WLD110 - Survey of Welding Processes and WLD115A -Welding NCCER Core High School Part A. The Course Catalog for the Skilled Trades & Technology Division can be found at <https://bit.ly/3UCGsDd>.

WLD110 is an "introductory course with a focus on the fundamentals and safety related to the Oxyfuel, Plasma Arc, and Carbon Arc cutting processes. Also included are the welding processes of Shielded Metal Arc, Gas Metal Arc, and Flux-cored Arc welding. The course is designed for the beginner and other CTE majors that require a basic knowledge of

WLD115A offers an "introduction to welding concepts and the National Center for Construction Education and Research

(NCCER) core curriculum. Topics include knowledge of all safety rules; pre- and post-equipment inspections; fundamental

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Back-to-back championships for the Hayden Lobos!

It has been a battle on the diamond for the Hayden baseball team this season, but it was a battle well fought by the defending 1A State Champions.

On May 10, the boys competed in the 2024 1A Baseball State Championship semifinals against the #1 seed, the Bagdad Sultans, the team the Lobos defeated last year to win the championship.

The first two innings of the game sat a 0-0 stalemate with both teams unable to break past one another. During the third inning, Hayden was the first to put points onto the scoreboard, collecting 3 runs. The Sultans retaliated by scoring 1 run in the fourth inning.

In the fifth inning, neither team scored any runs. The Lobos gave up 2 runs in the sixth inning. The score sat at 3-3 at the top of the seventh inning, and it stayed that way, sending the game into an eighth inning. The Lobos came out, not ready to give up. The boys collected 6 runs and gave up none. It was a Lobo victory, grabbed with dedication and desire. The final score of the eight-inning game was 9-3.

Eric Fox supplied aid for the Lobos going 3-for-5 at bat with 1 run, and 3 RBIs. Deondre Collier kept control from the pitcher's mound, only giving up 4 hits and 3 runs, but collecting 7 strikeouts. The Lobos came out on top, and ready for one more game.

The following day, the boys arrived at Tempe Diablo Stadium, ready to defend the champion title that they worked hard for last year. Meeting up with the Lobos in the championship game was the Lincoln Prep Lightning. The Lobos handily defeated the Lightning in a double header on April 23.

The Lobos came out swinging, collecting 4 runs during the first inning, while giving up none. The second inning saw the boys double down on the pressure, and scored 8 runs, still giving up no runs. In the third inning, the Lightning was able to get themselves on the board, with

3 runs.

During the fourth inning, the Lobos scored 2 runs, but gave up 3. The boys gave up 2 runs during the fifth inning. The Lobos finished the rest of the sixth and seventh inning by playing smart, and not letting anymore runs from the Lightning get past them. The boys kept the game in control. The game concluded with a final score of 14-8, the Lobos defended their den, and are now the two-time Arizona 1A State Baseball Champions.

The boys closed out their season with record of 24-5. Congratulations to Coach Robert Lorona and coaching staff, and to the entire team! You've brought great pride to your community, while your hard-work, dedication, and commitment to the sport is a testament to what it means to play Lobo baseball.

US 60 closures between Superior, Miami now set to begin May 16

SUPERIOR – The Arizona Department of Transportation reminds motorists who travel on US 60 between Miami and Superior to plan ahead for about six months of three times-a-week daytime closures starting Thursday, May 16. This start date is one day later than originally announced for a project involving rock blasting as work begins to replace the Queen Creek and Waterfall Canyon bridges.

When scheduled, the blasting will lead to closures of US 60 on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays between 9 a.m. and 2 p.m., a schedule the Arizona Department of Transportation designed to provide consistency for those who rely on this highway east of the Phoenix area. Closures are not expected to occur every Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday but will be limited to those days.

During closures, motorists will use a detour on state routes 77 and 177 through Winkelman. That roughly 68-mile route includes a 10 percent grade and will significantly increase travel time. Drivers may want to plan trips before or after the full closures because of the potential for delays.

Eastbound US 60 traffic will be redirected at State Route 177 in Superior, and westbound traffic will be redirected

at the west end of Miami. Traffic will not be allowed to queue at the closure locations.

Motorists with destinations between Miami and Magma Mine Road will be allowed to pass. No vehicles will be allowed between Superior and Magma Mine Road.

Drivers should expect lane restrictions and a reduced speed limit at all times in the work zone, along with a 12-foot vehicle width restriction. Please proceed with caution, slow down and watch for construction personnel and equipment.

The closures are required for the combined \$44.7 million project to replace the Queen Creek and Waterfall Canyon bridges with spans designed to handle passenger and commercial traffic for decades to come.

Toward the end of the project, a multi-day closure of US 60 will be required to finish realigning the highway with the new Queen Creek Bridge.

The new Queen Creek Bridge will span 763 feet and feature one lane of travel in each direction with 4-foot-wide shoulders. The replacement structure for the Waterfall Canyon Bridge will span 107 feet.

Once the Queen Creek Bridge is completed, crews will dismantle the existing structure, which opened to traffic

in 1994. While the bridge remains safe for traffic, it has reached the end of its lifespan and doesn't meet current standards for bridge design.

For safety reasons, construction will require closing some areas used by hikers, rock climbers

and other recreational areas. In the Queen Creek Bridge area, trails will close from Magma Avenue in Superior to the west of the Claypool Tunnel. The trail through the Claypool Tunnel, heading east past Waterfall Canyon Bridge, will remain open until later

in the project when active construction begins in this area.

In the Waterfall Canyon Bridge area, the US 60 pullout east of the Queen Creek Tunnel will close during the project. Other nearby pullouts may close intermittently.

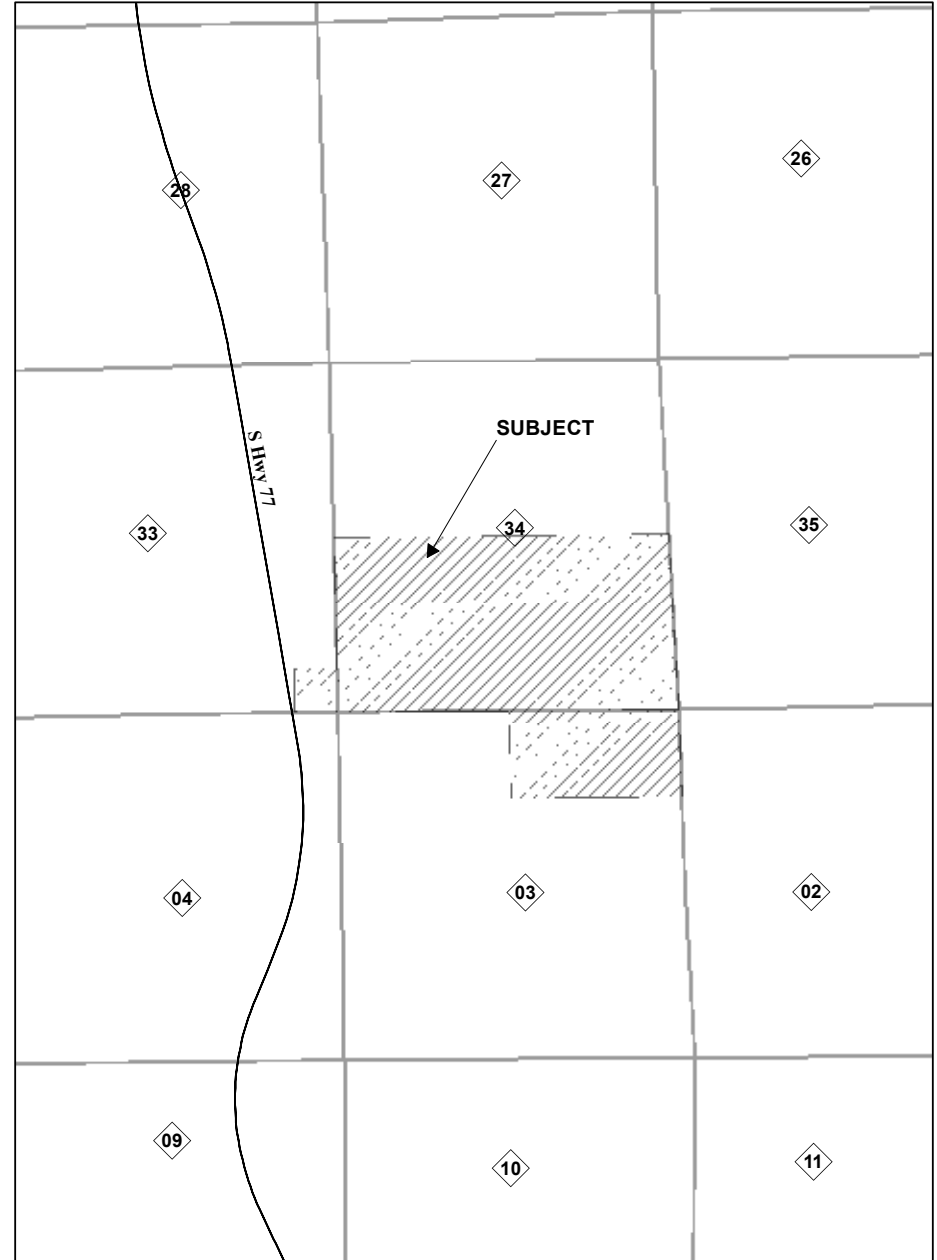
