Number of Arizona Travel IDs now exceeds 3 million; Get yours if you wish to use a state credential for domestic flights

The Arizona Department of Transportation Motor Vehicle Division has now issued more than 3 million Arizona Travel ID cards.

The federal requirement for domestic airline travelers to have a federally compliant ID is now in effect, meaning you will need an Arizona Travel ID, passport or other acceptable form of identification to more easily get past TSA checkpoints for domestic flights.

Join the 3 million – and counting – Arizonans who have

upgraded to the Arizona Travel ID and consider upgrading your credential at least two weeks before your next flight. The new card may take up to 14 days to arrive in the mail.

Without the Arizona Travel ID or other form of compliant identification, fliers risk missing an airline flight because the standard driver license may not be accepted or additional screening time may be required.

This federally compliant credential is distinguished by Continued on page 15



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Pinal County: New residential parking ordinance takes effect

On July 2, 2025, the Pinal County Board of Supervisors adopted Ordinance No. 070225-RD24-168, targeting parking on county roads and public rights-of-way in unincorporated residential areas. It prohibits parking of recreational vehicles (RVs), large trucks and trailers in subdivisions, unless parked on private property that meets specific zoning and setback guidelines. This ordinance does not affect rural or agricultural properties.

The ordinance had been considered following two public hearings. While the majority of the discussions were based around the larger and more populated subdivisions in the San Tan Valley area, this ordinance will be in effect county-wide, also affecting San Manuel, Oracle and other unincorporated areas. This ordinance is not applicable to incorporated municipalities; however, they may also have additional or similar parking ordinances.

RVs will be allowed to park in the front of properties for up to 48 hours when preparing to depart for a trip or a returning from a trip. This ordinance was brought into effect and studied because the county did not have any parking ordinances, to deal with a variety of engineering and safety issues that were becoming ongoing challenges for Pinal County.

Private property rules still apply: You may still keep these vehicles on your own lot, but they must comply with private setback, utility hookup, and zoning regulations under county code chapters 2.125 and 2.135. Owners may park

their vehicles and equipment in their driveways or backyards so long as they meet the proper setbacks and guidelines for their particular subdivisions and Homeowners Associations. There are also specific allowances for public utility workers who may bring their trucks home and public safety officials.

This ordinance will also prohibit nonoperating vehicles from being parked on the street for more than 48 hours. The ordinance does not include a delayed notice period before enforcement begins: it became effective immediately upon adoption on July 2, 2025, and citations can be issued right away. There are limited temporary allowances detailed in the ordinance: Heavy trucks (commercial vehicles ≥ 19,500 lb GVW) are permitted to remain on the street only if they are disabled and undergoing repairs—but must be off the public rightof-way within 48 hours.


RVs, buses, trailers, boats, and inoperable/unregistered vehicles parked on residential streets are similarly subject to removal if left for longer than 48 consecutive hours. If property owners do not comply within the 48hour grace period, the vehicle becomes eligible for: Towing at the owner's expense, vehicle immobilization, civil fines of at least \$250 per day.

Enforcement of the ordinance will carried out by either the Pinal County Sheriff's Office or Code Compliance, who may first issue warnings at their discretion. You can learn more by reading the ordinance in full online: https://bit.ly/44GHUt9.

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Seven things doctors wish families knew this back-to-school season

This silent epidemic affects people of all ages and backgrounds, striking at the core of their physical and mental well-being. Despite its widespread impact, the gravity of eating disorders often remains private, leaving many to battle the condition silently. If you believe your child or teenager has an eating disorder, their physician can direct you to helpful resources.

3. Ensure your vaccinations are up to date. Vaccinations help protect you and your family against severe disease and disability and save millions of lives each year. Check with your physician during the back-to-school season to ensure everyone in the family is up to date on vaccinations. When respiratory virus season starts later in the fall, get up to date on the influenza vaccine to help reduce time away from school or work. 4. Norovirus is very contagious, but preventable. It seems everyone has experienced the sudden turn of the stomach, causing a mad rush to the bathroom due to vomiting, diarrhea or both. And, unfortunately,

remaining near the

bathroom may be the only

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plan for the next day or two. The most likely culprit is norovirus, and it can happen to anyone. When buying school supplies, stock up on cleaning supplies as well so you can keep frequently touched surfaces sanitized. Model good hand-washing habits for your children. Keep children with norovirus symptoms home from school for at least two days (48 hours) after symptoms stop to help prevent the spread of the virus. 5. Too much screen time is bad for health. People are on their devices more than ever before. But too much screen time can have negative mental and physical health effects and increase feelings of loneliness. The start of a new school year is a good time to replace screen time with other activities, such as after school clubs and sports, playdates, quality family time and sleep. 6. Eye health is essential. Don't take eve health for granted. Fall is a good time for an ophthalmologist checkup. If your tween or teen wears contacts, be sure that they wash their lenses and lens case and take their lenses off at night. Frequent computer breaks, wearing sunglasses, and a healthy

diet can also promote good eye health.

7. Sleep is important for overall health. From school stress to illnesses. many factors can interfere with a good night's sleep. Instituting a consistent sleep routine for the entire family is a good start. For teens, 8-10 hours of sleep is recommended, and children aged 6-12 should be getting 9-12 hours of sleep. Consider consulting a physician for persistent sleep issues to determine whether they're caused by a sleep disorder and to get help.

a star in the upper right corner and is available to Arizona residents as a driver license or identification card.

To get an Arizona Travel ID, federal standards require the following:

• Proof of identity: a birth certificate or valid

passport

• Social Security number: just the number, not the card

• Two documents proving Arizona residency, such as rental or bank statements, credit card or cellphone bills in your name with vour current Arizona address

You can walk into an office for this service, but we suggest scheduling an appointment at azmvdnow.gov. Even if you haven't activated your AZ MVD NOW account, you can still schedule an appointment. You

can also go to any authorized third-party location, which may have extended hours, including Saturdays.
