Volunteer as a voice that matters! What it means to advocate for a child in foster care

“Being able to assist and positively influence the life of an innocent child is incredibly meaningful to me. In moments of displacement, it’s crucial that everyone involved receives the love and support they need. Knowing there’s someone on the other end of the line when things get tough can provide a sense of reassurance and comfort that is invaluable. I feel truly honored to play a role in making life a bit brighter and more peaceful for all the individuals affected,” said CASA Darla Carlisle when asked about how her time as a CASA impacts the children she serves.

Volunteering as a CASA for a child in foster care involves committing 10 to 15 hours each month to support that child, understand their needs, and follow their case.

“Being a CASA means that through a minimal investment of my time, I can reassure a foster child that they aren’t alone on their journey,” said CASA Tracy Pearson. This role ensures that the child has a consistent adult who genuinely cares about their well-being. These children have been removed from their homes due to neglect or

abuse, and they deserve to feel safe and heard.

“After several cases, I am amazed to discover the powerful impact I can have on a child by simply being a consistent adult presence who wants to spend time with them and is willing to listen to whatever they wish to discuss,” shares CASA Karrol Braddock. “It is essentially acknowledging that child as another person who merits care and consideration.”

Each child in foster care has a unique story and specific needs. When a child is paired with a CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocate), they gain someone who focuses solely on them. “It means opening your heart and sharing your time with a youngster or a group of siblings in need... someone who is exclusively there for them throughout the process,” explains CASA Cris Gerard. A CASA volunteer meets with the child monthly, attends hearings, participates in meetings, and advocates for the child’s needs.

The child welfare system is overwhelmed, with case managers responsible for multiple families. In contrast,

a CASA is dedicated to just one child or sibling group, focusing solely on ensuring the child’s safety and best interests.

“Being a CASA volunteer has been the most fulfilling way, for me, to be of service. As a student of social work, working with children, their guardians, parents, and the court has given me valuable experience” explained CASA Maria Moreno-McAlister. “However, this pales in comparison to being a small form of consistency, advocacy, and empowerment for children who are at their most vulnerable. To be able to witness the growth, resiliency, and hope that our kids have is uplifting.”

Currently, the CASA of Gila County Program faces a shortage of volunteers to meet the needs of our community. Many children would significantly benefit from having their own advocate, but there aren’t enough volunteers available to take on their cases. As children return to school this month, we anticipate an even greater demand for volunteers.

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ADOT: Make safety a priority if driving over the July Fourth weekend – no closures scheduled on state highways

PHOENIX – With no closures scheduled on state highways over the extended Fourth of July weekend, the Arizona Department of Transportation is joining other agencies, including first responders, in asking drivers to focus on safety and staying alert during holiday road trips.

Allow extra time during peak travel periods, including Thursday afternoon, July 3, and Sunday afternoon and evening, July 6.

ADOT and its contractors will be giving motorists a break by not scheduling state highway closures between Thursday afternoon and Sunday night.

Drivers should still expect the unexpected, including unscheduled highway closures due to crashes, disabled vehicles, wildfires or other incidents.

ADOT anticipates heavy traffic and possible delays on highways in and out of the Phoenix and Tucson areas during peak holiday weekend travel times. That includes the Interstate 17 Improvement Project work zone between Anthem Way and the Sunset Point Rest Area north of Phoenix.

Other highways expected to be busy at times include State Route 87 between Fountain Hills and Payson; US 93 between Wickenburg and Hoover Dam; I-10 between Tucson and Phoenix; and I-8 and I-10 between the Phoenix area and the California state line.

For summer travel, ADOT recommends preparing an emergency kit including extra drinking water. Other items to consider are blankets, a first-aid kit, a flashlight, extra batteries, a fully charged cellphone and charger, snacks, diapers if necessary and a small tool kit. More information about traveling in hot weather is available on the ADOT website.

Because travel delays are possible, don't forget other important items such as prescription medicines. A hat, sunglasses and umbrella – to help with rain or shade – also are good items to remember.

Be prepared for changing weather conditions, including blowing dust. Other road trip safety recommendations include:

- Avoid distractions. Don't text while driving. Eyes up, phones down.
- Check your vehicle, including tire pressure and engine fluid levels.
- Get some rest before traveling. Fatigue is a serious safety risk.
- Never drive while impaired. Buckle up and obey speed limits.
- Arrange for a designated driver or ride service if necessary.
- If towing a trailer, secure chains so they are not dragging on pavement and creating sparks that might start a brush fire.
- Avoid stopping in areas with grasses and brush. Hot vehicle components could start a fire.

ADOT will have personnel ready to respond to incidents along highways over the holiday weekend. In addition to on-call statewide maintenance crews, the ADOT Incident Response Unit (IRU), sponsored by GEICO, patrols Phoenix-area freeways in Maricopa County from 4 a.m. to midnight on weekdays and from 6 a.m. to 4 p.m. on weekends. The IRU operators assist state troopers as well as drivers in need of help. More

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HIVE campers raise their voices with anti-smoking and vaping PSA

This summer, the HIVE at the Superior Enterprise Center kept buzzing with creativity as campers attended a multi-day camp to learn more about technology and address public health concerns at the Mind and Motion Technology Exploration Camp. The local youth discussed a variety of health issues facing their community and then utilized the technology at the HIVE to create a powerful message in a meaningful media project, creating their very own Public Service Announcement (PSA) on the dangers of smoking and vaping.

The campers explored the impacts of nicotine addiction and how the long term health effects are dangerous. The campers used the gymnasium and the telemedicine room as the set for their PSA. The students presented their PSA on not smoking and vaping to their parents and community members at the HIVE, where they were each presented with a brand new iPad as a reward for their work. Following their local presentation, they were included in a larger PSA pitch event at the Apple Store at Scottsdale Fashion Square where Institute Digital

Equity and Acceleration staff and Apple Executives were also present to watch the presentations from the HIVEs across the metro Phoenix area and the Superior HIVE Camp.

The campers were responsible for writing scripts, storyboarding scenes, filming interviews, and editing together a short but impactful videos aimed at educating their peers. Their final PSAs delivered strong and clear messages: tobacco use may seem trendy, but the risks are real, and it's never too early to choose health or change habits.

"The HIVE gives our youth the tools to express themselves and address serious issues that affect their generation," said Mayor Mila Besich. "This PSA project shows how empowered young people can become powerful advocates for their own health and their community's well-being."

The HIVE has been open since March of 2025 and is one of the highest volume centers in the network of HIVEs.





Red Cross responders focus on the Copper Corridor

It happens once every few weeks. The Red Cross receives an emergency call from Winkelman or Mammoth, or some other part of the Copper Corridor. A home has caught fire and has been destroyed. A family of five is standing outside among piles of debris, on what had been their front lawn. Luckily, the fire department dispatcher has

called 1-800-REDCROSS to request emergency assistance.

A team of Red Cross responders is mobilized within a few minutes of the initial call. Help is on the way. But more often than not, it may be another hour or more before Red Cross volunteers arrive on site. This is because the distance between Mammoth and the nearest available responder – who is dispatched directly from his or her home – can easily be almost one hundred miles. Considering the limited number of roads that lead in and out of the area, adverse weather conditions or heavy traffic anywhere along the way can further reduce the response

time.

Such delays weigh heavily on the Red Cross, especially the volunteer responders, who are trained to provide immediate relief when disasters strike in cities and towns across Pinal County. It is a problem that arises every few years as local response volunteers age out of the system, move away, or migrate to other positions within the Red Cross. Similarly, at any point in time, volunteers may be temporarily out of commission due to illness, travel, or other commitments. This is a fixable problem, and the Red Cross is seeking the help of the community.

The best way for our communities to participate is to help us get the word out. Local organizations and clubs are invited to host Red Cross presentations as a public service. One or two hours is more than enough time for us to share the Red Cross response story with you, to field any questions or comments, and to assist interested members of the community in the process of signing up as a Red Cross volunteer.

When you take that first step toward response training with the Red Cross, you are taking an important step to becoming a valuable member of your community. You can help serve your community's needs, on a flexible schedule, often without leaving home. Understand that most disaster responses will require that you visit the affected family, but that family can easily be a friend or neighbor, or a fellow member of a community organization, a church, or a club. You would be joining your own neighborhood's support network.

The immediate question is “what is the commitment”? Your time is valuable and your priorities are for you to decide. All we ask is that you take a few hours of initial training and be available a few hours a month, at most, to respond to the victims of home fires. A single volunteer in each major town along the Copper Corridor is our immediate goal. That would be enough to respond to most incidents throughout the year. Your local presence would allow your displaced friends and neighbors to obtain more immediate assistance when they need it the most. Are you ready to be someone's hero?

Hayden Senior Center closing; Library wants to help

On Wednesday, June 25, 2025, Central Arizona Aging and the Town of Hayden announced that due to budget cuts, they would be dissolving their 50-year partnership, which effectively closed the Hayden Senior Center. Central Arizona Aging, a nonprofit organization, has provided funding to the Town of Hayden to serve healthy hot lunches every Monday – Thursday, while the town provided the Senior Center for seniors to congregate.

Although the Senior Center is closing, Central Arizona Aging realizes that nutrition for seniors is still a priority and will now be providing the Copper Basin Area with a Meals on Wheels program.

This program will provide seven frozen meals to all who register. Meals will be available for pickup every Monday, from 11 a.m. to noon in the Senior Center parking lot. If transportation is an issue, seniors can always delegate someone to pick up meals for them, or it can even be arranged for meals to be delivered. Monthly menus will be provided for participants.

With the news of the Senior Center Closing, Hayden Library is hoping to give local seniors a place to spend time as close to what they would normally spend together at the Senior Center.

“We already do a few things for seniors, but we are willing to do more,” said Jamie Wolgast, Library Clerk. She said they welcome all to come, sit together, even bring a lunch they would like.

“Anything we can do to help,” said Bea Bejarano, Lead Librarian.

The library has already done a few things such as hosting bingo events, but they are willing to listen to suggestions and see what they can do to make it work. Obviously, as a library, they don’t have the same amenities that were offered by the senior center, but it is great to see them stand up and help and kudos to the staff for attempting to restore a little of what has been lost.

Along with providing meals, Central Arizona Aging also provides seniors with legal aid, Medicare counseling, and health providers.

Applications can be picked up at the Town of Hayden and the Town of Winkelman. This program is available to

households in the Copper Basin Area with at least one resident who is over 60 years of age.

Central Arizona Aging also stated that they have been reaching out to Pinal and Gila County for any information on organizations that may want to help. Angela Skillings, with Town of Winkelman Town Council, also stated she would try bringing it to the Central Arizona Governments (CAG) and that they have been searching for grants to hopefully get the Senior Center reopened, but as of now, no promises have been made.

Hayden Senior Center will still be available to rent for events.
