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ADOT: Make safety a priority if driving over the July Fourth weekend – no closures scheduled on state highways

PHOENIX – With no closures scheduled on state highways over the extended Fourth of July weekend, the Arizona Department of Transportation is joining other agencies, including first responders, in asking drivers to focus on safety and staying alert during holiday road trips.

Allow extra time during peak travel periods, including Thursday afternoon, July 3, and Sunday afternoon and evening, July 6.

ADOT and its contractors will be giving motorists a break by not scheduling state highway closures between Thursday afternoon and Sunday night.

Drivers should still expect the unexpected, including unscheduled highway closures due to crashes, disabled vehicles, wildfires or other incidents.

ADOT anticipates heavy traffic and possible delays on highways in and out of the Phoenix and Tucson areas during peak holiday weekend travel times. That includes the Interstate 17 Improvement Project work zone between Anthem Way and the Sunset Point Rest Area north of Phoenix.

Other highways expected to be busy at times include State Route 87 between Fountain Hills and Payson; US 93 between Wickenburg and Hoover Dam; I-10 between Tucson and Phoenix; and I-8 and I-10 between the Phoenix area and the California state line.

For summer travel, ADOT recommends preparing an emergency kit including extra drinking water. Other items to consider are blankets, a first-aid kit, a flashlight, extra batteries, a fully charged cellphone and charger, snacks, diapers if necessary and a small tool kit. More information about traveling in hot weather is available on the ADOT website. Because travel delays are possible, don't forget other important items such as prescription medicines. A hat, sunglasses and umbrella – to help with rain or shade – also are good items to remember.

Be prepared for changing weather conditions, including blowing dust. Other road trip safety recommendations include:

• Avoid distractions. Don't text while driving. Eyes up, phones down.

• Check your vehicle, including tire pressure and engine fluid levels.

• Get some rest before traveling. Fatigue is a serious safety risk.

• Never drive while impaired. Buckle up and obey speed limits.

• Arrange for a designated driver or ride service if necessary.

• If towing a trailer, secure chains so they are not dragging on pavement and creating sparks that might start a brush fire.

• Avoid stopping in areas with grasses and brush. Hot vehicle components could start a fire.

ADOT will have personnel ready to respond to incidents along highways over the holiday weekend. In addition to on-call statewide maintenance crews, the ADOT Incident Response Unit (IRU), sponsored by GEICO, patrols Phoenix-area freeways in Maricopa County from 4 a.m. to midnight on weekdays and from 6 a.m. to 4 p.m. on weekends. The IRU operators assist state troopers as well as drivers in need of help. More

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information about ADOT IRU can be found on the ADOT website.

Real-time highway conditions are available on ADOT's Arizona Traveler Information site at AZ511.gov, the az511 app (download for Apple or Android devices) or by calling 511. ADOT also provides highway condition updates via its X feed, @ArizonaDOT.

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HIVE campers raise their voices with anti-smoking and vaping PSA

This summer, the HIVE at the Superior Enterprise Center kept buzzing with creativity as campers attended a multiday camp to learn more about technology and address public health concerns at the Mind and Motion Technology Exploration Camp. The local youth discussed a variety of health issues facing their community and then utilized the technology at the HIVE to create a powerful message in a meaningful media project, creating their very own Public Service Announcement (PSA) on the dangers of smoking and vaping. The campers explored the impacts of nicotine addiction and how the long term health effects are dangerous. The campers used the gymnasium and the telemedicine room as the set for their PSA. The students presented their PSA on not smoking and vaping to their parents and community members at the HIVE, where they were each presented with a brand new iPad as a reward for their work. Following their local presentation, they were included in a larger PSA pitch event at the Apple Store at Scottsdale Fashion Square where Institute Digital Equity and Acceleration staff and Apple Executives were also present to watch the presentations from the HIVEs across the metro Phoenix area and the Superior HIVE Camp.

The campers were responsible for writing scripts, storyboarding scenes, filming interviews, and editing together a short but impactful videos aimed at educating their peers. Their final PSAs delivered strong and clear messages: tobacco use may seem trendy, but the risks are real, and it's never too early to choose health or change habits. "The HIVE gives our youth the tools to express themselves and address serious issues that affect their generation," said Mayor Mila Besich. It then went to Wendy Hooky's shop My Cousins Closet until 2014. Finally, the farmers market found its home at Sue & Jerry's Trading Post, where it would continue from 2014 to 2025.

Local woman bakes up Parradise in sourdough bread

Tucked away in a little corner on Parradise Ranch, you will find Baking Parradise, a cottage bakery. Inside, you will smell the aroma of fresh locally baked sourdough, and will be greeted by the owner, Justine Parra. She is the granddaughter of Parradise Ranch owners, Sue and Jerry, and like her grandparents, she has a creative drive and a love for her community. It all started in the winter around 3 and a half years ago, when Justine had a dream.

"I had a dream I made the best bread ever, and it was like, such a cool dream, the next day, I started looking into different types of bread, and my friend had recently been telling me she got a bread maker. So I was like, oh, maybe I could do that," said Justine.

Eventually, she settled on sourdough, as her bread of choice, especially due to its health benefits.

It was a rough start, Justine said. "Terrible. No, it was so hard. Just maintaining a starter is hard, and it being winter was really hard. So I started, I think it was like when I got the hang of it was around Christmas time, so that worked out. So I could give like loaves for gifts, then I was giving it to friends and we kind of just spiraled from there."

Justine began selling her loaves at the farmers markets. Since she was working another job, the farmers markets lined up with her days off, allowing her the time to bake and sell for the market.

"So I was only doing Wednesdays at

first," she said. "Then people, you know, obviously Wednesdays doesn't work for everyone. So I started letting people come on the weekends. Then luckily, my grandparents let me use this room, because I started out doing two loaves at a time in my home oven, and it was like 9 million degrees inside, and my boyfriend wasn't happy. So I looked into getting a bread oven, I moved in here. It's really just grown, like crazy. So I do the markets now, I'm open on the weekends and then I also deliver to the coffee shop and Dickman's in Tucson. I think when I first started, like operating as a business, I was only making like eight loaves for a weekend, and that was going in like an hour. So then I was like, okay, I'll do 12, and then that was going just as fast. It just keeps growing literally every week."

Justine started doing pop up events at Stacks in Oro Valley, and after those went well, she reached out to Dickman's and gave them some samples, which landed her a spot in the store. As a longtime patron of Dickman's, she said this was one of her goals for the business from the beginning. She hopes to find a place in Marana, and Catalina to sell her loaves.

Justine would like to thank her parents, and grandparents for their support and inspiration. She would also like to thank the community, for showing their love and support to an upcoming business.
