Superior Dance Co. taking the NBA, WNBA by storm

Local dancers of the Superior Dance Company had the crowds at two major basketball games on their feet cheering!

When Superior Dance Company director Billie Jo Villaverde contacted a Phoenix Suns account executive about performing at an upcoming Suns game, they asked what type of dance they would be performing.

"I gave them an option: Baile Folklorico, Selena, or Hip-Hop," Villaverde said. "He liked the idea that we had options, but said they always have folklorico dancing and although it is a crowd favorite, they haven't had a Selena Tribute performance."

After sending him photos of their Dia de Los Muertos performance showing all the girls wearing their Selena costumes, he was floored!

"He especially liked the purple costumes and thought it would be perfect for 'La Cultura night' with purple being a major color in the Suns background, our purple costumes would stand out," Villaverde said. "He gave me a schedule and I picked one of the biggest games in March (the month Selena passed away in 1995) to use as a celebration of her life." It was the Phoenix Suns vs. Boston Celtics.

After their performance, the Suns rep said they were one of their top performances of the season and asked if they would be interested in dancing at a Phoenix Mercury game.

"Of course, I said yes!" Villaverde said. "When their season schedule came out, he called me and I had first pick."

She chose the biggest game of their regular season: Caitlin Clark and the Indiana Fever at Phoenix Mercury in June.

When the rep asked what the kids would be performing, Villaverde was emphatic.

"I said we are going to bring the house down with Hip-Hop! Even though my current dancers hadn't performed a hip-hop routine, I knew they were going to deliver a great performance!"

SDC started a Hip-Hop dance camp and soon Villaverde had dancers coming every week, not just from Superior, but driving from Miami, Kearny, and Mesa for class. The energy was high and these dancers couldn't wait for freestyle, to show off what



Ken attended Miami schools, was Homecoming King, and graduated from MHS in 1977. Throughout his high school years, Ken played varsity basketball for three years, varsity football for a year and a half and devoted most of his high school off-time preparing himself physically for the

Ken knew he wanted to coach basketball since he was in the second grade. What a vision for a seven-year-old! He spent a lot of his youth in the gym with his father, and his mother, Stella, always made sure he got to the YMCA on time and ready to play youth basketball. You could often find Ken shooting baskets at all hours at the Miami Gardens outdoor court. His selftraining included strapping his '64 Ford to his shoulders and using it as resistance as he pulled the weight to increase his strength and speed.

Some accomplishments in football include being named to the 1976 First Team All-Conference for the offensive roster; but Ken's place was on the basketball court. His honors included a 1975 Conference Championship, 1975 State Runners-Up title, named to the Second Team All Conference in 1976, and in 1977, Ken was named to the First Team All-Conference.

Ken graduated from Northern Arizona University with degrees in Business Administration, Accounting, Secondary and Elementary Education, and minors in Math and Physical Education. Upon graduation in 1985, he accepted a junior high teaching position where he taught math and P.E. for 17 years at Lee Kornegay Junior High and was named Teacher of the Year in 1991. His lifelong dream of being a coach materialized as he became the seventhgrade basketball coach, winning 14 championships in 17

Coach Vargas then moved to the high school, teaching math. He coached with his father for his first year and moved to the varsity position three years later. During his 17 years as head coach, Ken won several runnersup trophies for local tournaments, won five Conference Championships and was named Conference Coach of the Year four times. He was very humble but took pride in his "2015 Spirit of Cotton Fitzsimmons Award - for

the Demonstration of the Best Qualities of a Coach" award.

He cared deeply for all his students, often coming in before school, during lunch and after school to tutor math. His place was in the classroom and that is where he felt he made a difference. Ken often spent time just visiting with students that needed some extra encouragement or just needed time to talk. In the quiet of his heart, he bought shoes, meals, clothes, and even took beds for



athletes who did not have a bed to sleep in. Ken was an exemplary coworker, and because of his tenure, he was often called on for advice and guidance, always willing to

On Dec. 16, 2023, "Vandal Gym" was renamed to "Vargas Gymnasium" by the MHS Alumni Association and MUSD in honor of Coaches Dickie and Ken Vargas. These two Miami High graduates had 89 combined years of teaching and 71 years of coaching the Miami Vandal Basketball
